## NOTICE

### **(Addendum to General Information & Instructions for PG Admission 2020)**

This is for information to all concerned that the following 'Tie Break' condition is being added to the notification CU/Acad/PG Admissions/2020/181/549c on General Information & Instructions for Admission to PG Programmes 2020-21, under the section 'MODE OF ADMISSION' on page 1:

#### **C) TIE-BREAKING**

A. In case where candidates secure equal CPGEE scores in a subject wherein graduation with Honours/Major in that subject is an eligibility criterion, the following criteria for calculation of CGPA to break the tie will be adopted:

- (i) For a candidate who passed the qualifying examination as mentioned in the eligibility criteria in 2020, **the CGPA (Honours/Core/Major) up to 5<sup>th</sup> Semester and that up to 6<sup>th</sup> Semester will be compared and the better of the two shall be considered.**
- (ii) For a candidate having appeared in the qualifying examination in 2020 but results not yet declared **the CGPA (Honours/Core/Major) up to 5<sup>th</sup> Semester shall be considered.**
- (iii) For a candidate having passed the qualifying examination in 2019 or earlier the CGPA up to 6<sup>th</sup> Semester shall be considered.

The candidate having the higher CGPA considered as explained above will be offered admission first.

- (iv) If after using the condition (i) to (iii) above there still is a tie of more than one candidate then **the CGPA of all subjects** (i.e. including Major, General Elective, Pass Course papers etc.) appeared by the candidates for qualifying degree in (i) to (iii) above will be considered.

The candidate having the higher CGPA will be offered admission first.

B. In case where candidates secure equal CPGEE scores in an **interdisciplinary subject**, the following criteria for calculation of CGPA to break the tie will be adopted:

- (i) For a candidate who passed the qualifying examination as mentioned in the eligibility criteria in 2020, **the CGPA of all subjects (as applicable) up to 5<sup>th</sup> Semester and that up to 6<sup>th</sup> Semester will be compared and the better of the two shall be considered.**
- (ii) For a candidate having appeared in the qualifying examination in 2020 but results not yet declared **the CGPA of all subjects (as applicable) up to 5<sup>th</sup> Semester shall be considered.**
- (iii) For a candidate having passed the qualifying examination in 2019 or earlier **the CGPA of all subjects (as applicable) up to 6<sup>th</sup> Semester shall be considered.**

The candidate having the higher CGPA considered as explained above will be offered admission first.

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- (iv) If after using the condition (i) to (iii) above there still is a tie of more one candidate then **the CGPA of respective Honours/Core/Major subjects** appeared by the candidates for qualifying degree in (i) to (iii) above will be considered.

**Marks to CGPA conversion**, wherever required under the above mentioned criteria, shall be according to the formula

**CGPA = Aggregate percentage of marks divided by 10, correct to two decimal places.**
