Admission Notice for remaining seats in Post-graduate Programmes 2024

It is hereby notified to all concerned that admissions for the remaining seats in various post-graduate subjects/departments of Cotton University will be held **tentatively** on:

Please note that there are **NO VACANT SEATS** in the following subjects/departments:

Bodo, Master of Commerce (M.Com.), Molecular Biology and Biotechnology (MBBT), Geology, Sociology, and Zoology

Students seeking admission to the remaining seats in the other subjects/departments are hereby strongly urged to go through the following points carefully.

POINTS TO BE NOTED

1. Presenting all the mark-sheets of ALL undergraduate semesters (1st – 6th semester) is mandatory for ALL candidates seeking admission into any post-graduate programmes of Cotton University.
2. Any such candidate MUST PASS ALL his/her undergraduate courses, without any backlog in ANY course, be it major, minor or any other course.
3. The seats under the Cotton Graduate category in any subject, which currently remain unoccupied, will now be converted to the open category.
4. **ONLY** those students, who had appeared in the cotton Post-Graduate Entrance Examination (CPGEE), will be considered during this round of admission.

5. Those students, whose CPGEE score was below the cut-off marks for admission on the 10th of August, 2024, will be called first for admission.
6. Only if any seat lies unoccupied after all such candidates (as mentioned in point 3 above) are called and/or admitted, candidates whose CPGEE score was above the cut-off marks on 10th August, 2024, in each category or subject, will then be called for admission.
7. For any candidate claiming admission under the OBC category, presenting a valid Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) certificate is a must.
8. One seat each from **ONLY** such departments, where one or more OBC seats lie unoccupied, will be kept aside for the special six (6) OBC categories: Ahom, Tea-Garden, Koch Rajbongshi, Chutia, Moran, and Matak.
9. Break-up of the remaining seats in the six special categories:
Ahom = 2; Tea-Garden = 3; Koch Rajbongshi = 1; Chutia = 2; Moran = 1; Matak = 1
10. The seats, mentioned in point 8 above, will be admitted towards the end, beginning with the highest CPGEE scorer from students among those six communities. *Please note that production of non-creamy layer certificate is mandatory for these seats as well.*

It MUST be noted that inter-conversion among the 6 special categories is **NOT PERMISSIBLE**; thus, a seat allotted to the Ahom community, even if remains unoccupied, cannot be converted to a seat for the Moran community, for example.

11. Any seats remaining unoccupied under the point 8, will then be converted to the OBC category.
12. Any seat that may remain after the admission of the OBC category candidates (as mentioned in point 11) will finally be converted to the unreserved category.

For the following subjects, candidates who had appeared in the CPGEE in the relevant subject and are interested to get admitted, may come forward, until the exhaustion of such seats in the respective subject/department:

Arabic, Bengali, Sanskrit, Statistics, and Law

Their admissions will take place on the basis of their CPGEE score, merit-wise.
