NOTIFICATION

Lateral Entry Admission into 3rd Semester of Four Year Undergraduate Programs (FYUGP) 2025

The students from other recognised universities/institutions willing for lateral entry need to apply via dedicated portal meant for the purpose. Applicants need to fulfil the following conditions for admission via lateral entry-

- i. Admission into the 3rd semester of undergraduate programme shall be permitted only after successful completion of first two semesters of NEP-2020 based FYUGP.
- ii. The available seats in various programs across the departments are mentioned in Annexure 1.
- iii. Regarding eligibility and required subject mapping, detailed information is available in Annexure II.
- iv. The courses & credits of the admitted applicants would be aligned as per NEP 2020 structure adopted by Cotton University.
- Cotton University after evaluation of applications shall notify the list of selected applicants for admission through lateral entry.
- Mere fulfilment of eligibility criteria does not guarantee admission and University might cancel the admission of the student if any discrepancy is found out at a later stage.
- The process of admission will be further guided by the norms mentioned in Govt Notification *Ecf No: 639138/16 dated 14th August, 2025* issued by the Directorate of Higher Education, Govt. of Assam.

Documents Necessary for Admission:

- Print out copy of Application Form
- Pass Certificate and Mark sheet of the Qualifying Examination (H.S. or equivalent 10+2 Examination from a recognized board or council)
- First Semester and Second Semester Mark Sheets of FYUGP program attended last.
- Reserved Category Certificate, if applicable. Only certificates issued by competent authority under the Government of Assam shall be deemed valid.
- Transfer/No-Objection Certificate from Head of the Institution last attended.
- Candidates seeking admission under EWS category will have to bring in valid Income and Asset certificates issued by a competent authority under the Government of Assam.

- In case, fee waiver is claimed, the relevant documents from appropriate authority as per Govt. Norms must be submitted.
- In case the admission committee is unable to verify a document submitted online, then the concerned candidate may be required to physically visit the University to show the original document for verification. The candidate will be duly notified through the contact number or email ID provided in his/her online application in such a case.

Preparation of Merit List:

Cotton University after evaluation of all criteria and conditions shall notify the list of selected applicants for admission through lateral entry.

- Merit list will be based on cumulative percentage or grades of first two semesters of the student in FYUGP.
- Merit list will be prepared separately for each major department.
- In case of tie of marks, the Cotton University rules will be followed for tie breaking.

Note 1:

If at any stage, any original document of an applicant is found to be fake or fabricated or in any other unsolicited manner or if any applicant is found to have furnished wrong information, the said applicant will not be admitted and if already admitted, admission will be cancelled without any prior notice in this regard. If the same is found after completion of the Programme of Study, the applicant's degree will be cancelled and appropriate legal action will be taken against him/her.

Note 2:

Students admitted will have to produce all original documents at the time of verification which will be notified by the University Authority at an appropriate time on University website. For any candidate failing to produce their original documents during verification, his/her admission will stand cancelled.

Hostel Admission:

Hostel allotment may require a separate procedure at a later stage after the admission and will be taken care of by Office of the Director-Students' Welfare at an appropriate time.

Canvassing & Ragging:

- Canvassing in any form for getting admission shall render a candidate disqualified.
- Ragging in any form is strictly banned in the University. In this regard, a signed undertaking of the Guardian shall have to be submitted at the time of admission as per verdict of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
